Dr. Konstantinos Zaralis is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Agriculture, School of Agricultural Sciences, University of Western Macedonia (UoWM). Konstantinos holds a Master's Degree in Animal Production and Nutrition from the University of Aberdeen (2004) and a PhD in Animal Science from the School of Biological Sciences, University of Edinburgh, UK (2008).

He pursued his postdoctoral research at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU) and upon completion he acquired a position as Assistant Professor in Animal Husbandry at the same University. During his years at SLU, he conducted research with ruminants focused on diet selection, chewing behaviour and animal productivity, while he was teaching Animal Nutrition, Animal Physiology and Biochemistry. In 2014 he accepted a position as Senior Livestock Researcher at the Organic Research Centre, UK, leading the Livestock Research Program. He has coordinated Work Packages in major research EU FP7 and H2020 projects (SOLID, ISAGE) and has participated in a number of other European and National research projects (REKS, ICOPP, AGFORWARD, OPTGRAZE and more).

Konstantinos has considerable experience in the preparation of competitive research proposals and in coordination of research programs. He is a member of scientific societies, a member of the Editorial Board of the Tropical Animal Health and Production and has served as a reviewer in many reputable scientific journals. He has published more than 45 papers in total (in scientific journals, conference proceedings, book chapters, scientific reports, etc.).
